Accelerated Learning Center will begin the school year with ALC Distance Learning on **August 12**. Governor Doug Ducey announced recently that in-person learning will be delayed until August 17, 2020. ALC Distance Learning will continue until the Governor announces that in-person learning can resume.

This is our current plan for school in the Fall:

- **ALC Distance Learning (Starting August 12):** Students will attend school every day from home through a structured, engaging online platform led by their ALC teachers. Devices can be loaned from ALC to students who do not have a device to complete their assignments.

When In-Person Learning resumes:

1. Students will have the option to continue school through ALC Distance Learning.

Or

2. Students will attend school, in person. ALC will implement CDC guidance on campus. Students will be evenly split between AM and PM sessions to ensure that class sizes are small. Space between desks will be maximized in addition to the other measures that have been taken as mentioned on the previous email sent out on June 29.

Accelerated Learning Center will continue to monitor and follow guidance from State and County Health Departments, which may result in changes to the above options.

The ALC Staff spent the summer redesigning ALC Distance Learning classes to be more motivating and engaging. We are here to support you and are eager to continue to make a difference for all of our students this fall.
